Dinner will be bangers & mash; if you are a vegetarian or have some other dietary requirements, please let me know ASAP. Call or message me on 07411 821418.

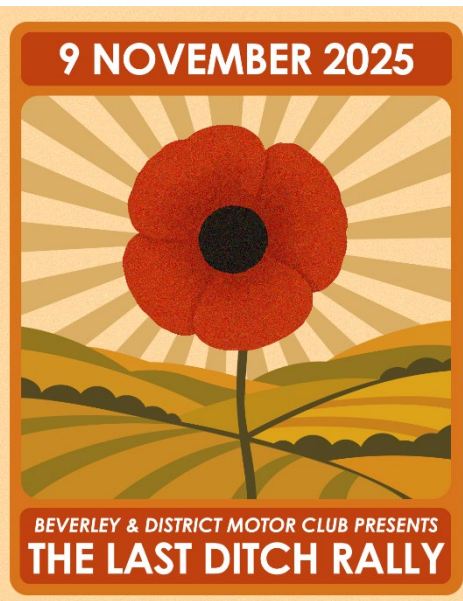
Dogs are welcome in the pub, but please note they are not permitted in the back room.

Classes & Route Information

There will be two classes of navigation - Novice and Expert.

If you haven't already done so, please log on to your entry and select a class.

Novice entrants will be given a roadbook which they should follow exactly, together with a marked map.

Experts will receive the 12 car navigational instructions, unmarked maps, and a set of "cheat" envelopes which they may use if they get stuck. Experts will be asked for unopened cheat envelopes at the end of the event. Please note that the instructions won't work on the modern OS map!

En route you will come across route checks in the form of code boards: please write them down on the page provided, and return them to me at the end of the event. Code boards apply to Novices and Experts equally.

If you come across any gates en route please ensure they are closed behind you.
