Foreword

Beverley & District Motor Club are organising a Touring Assembly for Classic Cars and Modern Cars of Significant Interest. The event will take place on Sunday 31 May 2026, starting and finishing at Field House Coffee Barn near Tibthorpe in the East Riding of Yorkshire, where a hot drink and sandwich will be provided before you set off.

The event will cover approximately 95 miles across East and North Yorkshire on Ordnance Survey Maps 100, 101 and 106. Most people will not have been on the roads we're using before, and some of the views are fantastic.

There will be an opportunity for lunch, toilets and even a garden centre at Castle Howard or time to enjoy a picnic. Petrol will be available after 62 miles.

The finish of the event will be back where we started with more food opportunities.

The road sections will not be timed or competitive, and there will be interesting snippets along the way as part of your road book. Navigation will either be a normal tulip and mileage road book, or a marked map to ensure absolute beginners can take part.

To add a spice of competition, there will be a number of simple, non-timed, non-damaging, fun gymkhana type tests along the route. These are not compulsory. Prizes for these will be provided.

Regulations

1. **Announcement**

Beverley & District Motor Club will organise a Touring Assembly on Sunday 31 May 2026. The event will be known as the Beverley Midsummer Tour.

2. **Jurisdiction**

Held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations (SRs) and any written instructions (including bulletins) that the organising club may issue for the event.

3. **Authorisations**

Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption has been applied for.

Motor Vehicles (Competitions and Trials) Regulations approval has been applied for.

4. **Route**

The event will start and finish at Field House Coffee Barn ([///recruiter.offline.detect](https://recruiter.offline.detect)), 53.984139, -0.58354 or OS Map 106 reference 929551. The route will be entirely contained on OS Maps 100, 101 and 106, and will comprise approximately 95 miles on sealed surface roads. There will be points of interest along the way and route information to look out for, which will help us to check you have taken the right route. To be classed as a finisher, you will be asked to present the route check information that you have written down, by handing in your route card. No roads will be used that are considered car damaging or a tight squeeze.

5. **Vehicles Eligible**

We are targeting classic cars to the event, but are also looking for more interesting modern cars. However, if you would like to take part in your standard modern car, you won't be turned away.

6. **Lunch Halt**

There will be an upto one hour lunch halt at Morrisons/KFC/McDonald's near Scarborough. However, we'd prefer you minimise your time there and instead support the Field House Coffee Barn which is opening especially for the event.

7. **Timing**

Check in opens at 09:00, and the first car will leave at 10:15, with each subsequent car at minute intervals. Participants must arrive 30 minutes before their due time to leave. Breakfast will be available from 09:30 until you leave. Approximate return time is estimated to be 14:00 to 15:00, assuming an approximately one hour lunch stop. There is no timing element to this event, you are free to proceed at your own pace.

8. **Entries**

Entries open on publication of these regulations, and all entries must be made on the [rallies.info website](https://rallies.info). Entries close 1 hour before the start. The maximum number of entrants is 50. If the number of entries exceeds 50, preference will be given to the vehicles identified in paragraph 5 above.

9. Entry Fees

The entry fee for the event is £38, and payment can be made online after you have entered. The entry fee covers 2 people in the car. Entries without payment are not valid.

10. Additional Passengers

Additional passengers can be carried in the car for an additional £10 per person

12. Final Instructions

Final instructions, including a start time for each car, will be published in the week before the event. These carry the same authority as these regulations.

13. Signing-On

Signing on will take place electronically in the 2 weeks before the event.

14. Driving Standards

The route covers many country roads including narrow lanes etc. As ever, we ask you to always be considerate of other road users, particularly cyclists, horse riders and walkers. Please drive very quietly and steady through all villages that are not on a main road, ideally at no more than 20mph.
