Beverley & District Motor Club is committed to reducing and balancing the carbon impact of the East Riding Stages Rally. One of the ways in which we do this is by using Carbon Positive Motorsport to measure, report, and offset all competitor fuel emissions.

We recognise that sustainability must be practical as well as ambitious. By taking clear, measurable steps and sharing our results openly, we want to show that sustainable motorsport is achievable and to set an example for other events across the UK.

We are committed to running motorsport events responsibly. Sustainability is central to protecting the future of our sport. Our approach is practical, achievable, and rooted in the reality of a volunteer club.

What we measure



Competitor fuel use is calculated and recorded in Motorsport UK's carbon calculator. We also gather data on travel to and from the event by competitors and officials, to build a clear picture of emissions over time.

What we do



Every litre of competitor fuel is offset at 200%. This is achieved through a mix of accredited international Carbon Reduction Units and UK-based Pending Issuance Units, which directly support rewilding and biodiversity projects. These measures ensure the rally remains climate positive.

By entering, spectating, or supporting the East Riding Stages Rally, you are part of an event that demonstrates motorsport can lead on sustainability, making the sport more resilient for the future.
