### **Final Instructions**

We would like to thank you all for entering and hope you enjoy a social day on some of the best roads the Yorkshire Wolds and Forests can throw at you!

We would like to remind you that there is no timing and it is not a race. The roads we have chosen are rarely used by others, but please be aware that someone could be coming the other way.

Most of the roads are typical road rally or 12-car roads, but during the day, the views are wonderful.

Please arrive 09.00 to 09.30 a.m. for your route and rally plate. Follow the arrows to the rear of the Barn. The seeding is as the entry number. A ticket will be provided for each person, two per car unless you have paid for more, for up to £9.50 per person which will at least cover a hot egg and sausage/bacon sandwich and a tea or coffee.

The first car will be due to leave at 10.15 a.m. after doing a simple, non-damaging game. There are four more games in lay-bys en route, none of which are mandatory, they are just for fun and to add a little bit of competition.

There are a number of arrow letter boards enroute which should be recorded and when you unscramble the anagram will make a word, which is the treasure!

The two-thirds halt is at McDonalds/KFC/Morrisons, south of Scarborough and parking is in the general car park. There is no official control here, but food and drink and toilets are available at a number of the food outlets or you can bring a picnic to have en route, but ideally after the last game which is after Silpho Village. Food and Drinks are available at the end of the event; they are very kindly staying open for us but you would need to be back by 3.00 p.m. to order food. If you could spend your money back at Field House Coffee Barn, that would be appreciated, as they have been very supportive of our event. Thank you.

A reminder – Field House Coffee Barn is halfway between Tibthorpe and Huggate, map reference 929551 or What Three Words: Recruiter. Offline. Detect

Marked Route maps will be provided, so you do not need a map. This is for beginners, alternatively a traditional Tulip Road Book with mileages will be provided.
